

A SUMMARY OF LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The following is a description of our local scholarships. It is always a good idea to verify that you have the correct information with the organization making the award or by contacting Dollars for Scholars. **Scholarships requiring Harney Co application must include all required essays, activities chart as listed at the bottom of the application and specific additional essays and letters of reference requested by each organization as indicated below.**

Local Scholarships in due date order:

BURNS ELKS MOST VALUABLE STUDENT: Early January \$600. Elks application & interview. Pick up application & return to Burns Elks Lodge. \$1000 scholarship available to one boy and one girl with payment made over 4 years (\$250 per year in college). High school senior in Harney County. Burns Elks lodge#1680, 118 N. Broadway, Burns.

OTEC SCHOLARSHIP: January 15th. Two \$1500 scholarships available. Family must be an OTEC customer. Requires a two-page OTEC application. High School senior in Harney Co. OTEC P. O. Box 226, Baker City, OR 97814

RAY AND MILDRED WEEKS: February 1st. Full tuition for one year. Must attend EOU. Use Weeks scholarship application. Preference given to business and education majors. 3.0 gpa. A second award available to an EOU enrollee taking courses at the regional center. Must be a Harney Co resident for past 3 years. High School seniors and undergraduates eligible.

HARNEY FUTURES: February. \$200. Must be enrolled off campus in a course from TVCC or EOU. Short application required, two essays and two letters of recommendation.

HARNEY COUNTY 4-H MEMORIAL: February 25th. \$300+. Must be a 4-H member for 3 years prior to application. A standard 4-H application form is used or Harney Co application. Turn application into Extension office.

LIONS POTEET: March 1st. \$1500 renewable for 1- 4 years. Several awarded annually. Apply through OSAC. An autobiographical essay is required. Harney Co High School seniors. 3 references required. Academic and vocational scholarships available.

LIONS JEFF HULL MEMORIAL: March 1st. \$600. Apply through OSAC. An essay on how music has or will affect your life is required. Harney Co High School seniors & undergraduates.

LIONS OSTER: March 1st. \$1000. Apply through OSAC. Additional essay is required showing volunteer service. Harney Co High School seniors & undergraduates.

LIONS GUNTHER: March 1st. \$1500. Apply through OSAC. Additional essay is required showing work ethic. Harney Co High School seniors & undergraduates.

GREATER OREGON FEDERAL CREDIT UNION: March 1st. \$1000. Must be a member. Harney Co scholarship application. Parents past 2 years financial information required and 2 letters of recommendations. Harney Co high school seniors. May award more than one. Apply at the credit union at 743 Hines Blvd. Burns.

RICHARD COWAN MEMORIAL: March 1st. \$1000. Renewable each year. Apply through OSAC. Harney Co high school seniors. Parents must be Harney Co residents. Not available every year.

WOODIE & MABLE BEST: March 1st. \$1000. Apply through OSAC. Harney Co seniors (3.0 gpa) and undergraduates (2.75 gpa. Must have graduated from Harney Co high school).

CAROLYN DAVIES MEMORIAL: March 1st. \$500. Apply through OSAC. Harney Co high school seniors.

RON MCKENZIE: March 1st. Award amount varies. 2-yr varsity letter in football, basketball, or volleyball required. Application through BHS counselor. Selection done by committee.

NILE AND ANN WILLIAMS: March 15th. \$1000. Typed **Complete** Harney Co Application. Selection done by Committee. Mail to P. O. Box 243, Hines.

HIGH DESERT MEDICAL CENTER: April 1st. \$1000. Harney Co Application. Submit to High Desert Medical. Additional essay required "Why best candidate for this scholarship". Must be going into a science field. **Three teacher references required.**

FAITH BAPTIST CHURCH. April 1st. Must be regular attendee at Faith Baptist Church. Applications available at the church. Harney Co high school seniors or undergraduates.

HARNEY COUNTY CATTLEWOMEN: First Monday in April. \$500. Harney Co Application. Preference given to students whose parent or grandparent is a member of Cattlewomen or who is majoring in an ag field. Harney Co high school seniors. Pick up and turn in application to Extension office. Two letters of reference required and outline of the sources of college funding.

KIWANIS ROBERT K WOOD MEMORIAL: April 1st. \$500. Preference given to student majoring in medical field. Harney Co application. Harney Co high school seniors. Mail application to Kiwanis, Box 793, Burns.

KIWANIS DON MILLER MEMORIAL: April 1st. \$500. Preference given to student pursuing technical/vocational field. Harney Co application. Harney Co high school seniors. Mail application to Kiwanis, Box 793, Burns.

TIM SMITH MEMORIAL: April 1st. \$1000. Harney Co application. Harney Co high school senior. Must be attending Wyoming Technical Institute. Must include a letter of interest, 2 letters of recommendation, and proof of graduation. Obtain and return application to Cyndy Marshall, Box 584, Burns.

HARNEY HOSPITAL FOUNDATION: April 1st. \$500 to BHS senior and \$500 to CHS senior. Harney Co application + additional essay "Student background. What is your motivation to enter a health profession. What health care setting do you see yourself in 10 years. How do you plan to finance your education". Mail complete Harney Co application + essay to 557 W. Washington, Burns.

MASONIC ROBERT K WOOD MEMORIAL: April 15th. \$1000. Preference given to person majoring in a medical field. Harney Co application. Harney Co high school senior. Include 2 references. Mail to P. O. Box 997, Burns.

HOLY FAMILY CATHOLIC CHURCH. April 15th. \$500. Must be a church member. BHS high school seniors and undergraduates. Application available from the church.

MARION LASHBAUGH MEMORIAL: May 1st. \$500. Harney Co female attending OSU. Harney Co application submitted to counselor.

CLARA HANLEY: May 1st. \$500. Harney Co application submitted to counselor. Multiple awards. Selection made by committee.

STERLING SAVINGS BANK : May 1st. \$500. Harney Co application submitted to counselor. Selection made by committee.

HARNEY COUNTY FARM BUREAU: May 1st. \$500. Preference given to science or ag related field. Indicate on your application if parents are members. Membership not required by preferred. Harney Co application submitted to counselor.

LINK HAWLEY MEMORIAL: May 1st. \$500 to BHS senior and \$500 to CHS senior. Must be pursuing vocational or technical two-year degree. Harney Co application submitted to counselor.

JAMES D MCDADE TRUST: May 1st. McDade scholarship application. CHS seniors. Application submitted to high school counselor. Must live and attend school within the boundaries of CHS 8 years and attended a local grade school 4 years and CHS 4 years. Awards given if ranked in the top third of CHS class.

JACK DAVIES MEMORIAL: May 1st. CHS seniors. Must have attended CHS 2 years. Application obtained from counselor. Must include a letter, resume, & 3 letters of recommendation. Award not made every year.

HARNEY CO DOLLARS FOR SCHOLARS: May 1st. \$300-\$750. Multiple awards. Preference given to those who have not received any other local scholarship. Submit front page of Harney Co application to counselor.

DOUBLE O DISTRICT #28: Third week of May. \$1000. Must have attended Double O School for 3 years and reside in the county. Harney Co application. Mail to Georgia Marshall, Box 756, Hines.

CLEMENS FOUNDATION TUITION GRANT: Crane seniors who have lived within the boundaries of CHS for 8 years and attended a local grade school for 4 years and CHS for 4 years. Submit letter showing interest. Award decisions subject to committee decision.
